
Kids Chance California Educating Children of Injured Workers

Kids' Chance of California is a 501(c)3 non-profit charitable organization whose mission is to provide need-based educational scholarships to the children of California workers who have been fatally or seriously injured on the job.

Why Kids' Chance?

According to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics, there were 5,190 fatal occupational injuries in the United States in 2021 (8.9% increase from 2020) with 462 in California alone. Workplace injuries represent unsafe working conditions. Serious accidents can have a devastating impact on families, especially children, as parents must face the hurdle of funding their children's education—the key to their future and ours. Together, with your help, we can make a difference in California.
