Why Kids' Chance?

According to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics, there were 5,486 fatal occupational injuries in the United States in 2022 (5.7% increase from 2021) with 504 in California alone. Workplace injuries represent unsafe working conditions. Serious accidents can have a devastating impact on families, especially children, as parents must face the hurdle of funding their children's education—the key to their future and ours.
