Kids' Chance of California is a 501(c)3 non-profit charitable organization whose mission is to provide need-based educational scholarships to the children of California workers who have been fatally or seriously injured on the job.

Why Kids' Chance?

According to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics, there were 5,283 fatal occupational injuries in the United States in 2023. In California alone, 504 workers lost their lives on the job in 2022, reflecting the ongoing risks in our workplaces. These tragedies often leave families, especially children, facing emotional and financial hardship. The loss of a parent can make funding a child's education an overwhelming challenge. With your support, we can help ensure that these children still have access to the future they deserve. Together, we can make a meaningful difference in California.
